Board Members in Attendance: Mike Johnson, Sarah Kay, Craighton Chin, Steve Barton, Steve Lynch.

Q2 Treasurers Report (Craighton): The current balance for the club is \$7,571. The endowment balance is \$10,365 (July 24th, 2018).

New GVH Club Singlet Order (Craighton): The club is running short of men's singlets to give to new members who join the club. We can wait a year to order new women's singlets. Craighton shared several lightweight samples that were passed around. The current gold color is harder to find from vendors. An informal vote was made to change to a different color (red) that was voted down in favor of continuing with gold for a future club singlet order.

Summer Retreat (June 13-15, Joannie Siegler): The event was held in Truckee at a ski lodge rented by Mark and Joann Helmus that worked well. The number of attendees was 26. The revenues (in) and expenses (out) for the club were both ~\$860. The Friday dinner was pizza, and the Saturday dinner was a BBQ. The club will plan to organize this event again next year.

Sudwerk's Beer Week Race (August 2017 event, Mike): No event is being planned this year as the new event coordinator at Sudwerk's has not reached out to GVH for help with a similar event this year.

New GVH Gear Purchase (Mike): Mike sent out a Survey Monkey e-mail to gauge interest for a group purchase, but there was not sufficient interest (minimum of 24 orders of the same item) to make an order at this time. 18 people were interested in a (white) running cap, 13 were interested in a visor, and there was negligible interest in new shirts.

Holiday Party (Mike): The Davis Community Church is currently reserved by GVH for this event for December 15th, but some people are interesting in moving this to January so that more people can attend or be involved with the planning committee. An informal vote indicated a preference for having the event in January. Mike will send out an e-mail survey (Survey Monkey) to the club distribution list on a preferred date for this event. An announcement will be sent out later about forming a planning committee for the holiday party. Joannie Siegler and Steve Lynch will tentatively be involved with the planning committee.

Cross Country Season (Fall): The team captains will be Jose Zaragoza for the open men, Craighton Chin for the master's men, and Joannie Seigler for the women. The first race in the series is August 18th in Santa Cruz. The first target race for the women will be August 25th in Santa Rosa. The first target race for the master's men is September 9th at Golden Gate Park. The first target race for the open men will be September 15th in Carmichael (Ancil Hoffman Park). Six (6) races get scored for the Grand Prix series. GVH club members need to also be USATF members to contribute to the Grand Prix scoring.
